CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAM

Within the framework of the regulations determined by the Higher Education Planning, Supervision, Accreditation and Coordination Board (YÖDAK) and Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University, students from Northern Cyprus and international countries are accepted to this undergraduate program. After the university entrance exam held by the university for the citizens of Northern Cyprus, the students make their program preferences. The student who has obtained sufficient points for the program from the exam is placed in the relevant department.

GRADUATION CONDITIONS AND RULES

The language of instruction of the program is English and its duration is 4 (four) years. In order for students to graduate from this undergraduate program, their GPA must not be less than 2.00/4.00. Students must have completed all courses with at least DD/S letter grade. The minimum ECTS credits required for graduation is 240.

RECOGNITION AND EVALUATION OF PRIOR EDUCATION

At Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University, full-time students may be exempted from certain courses in accordance with the relevant regulation. If the content of the courses previously taken from another higher education institution is equivalent to the courses given in the Nursing Department of Cyprus Health and Social Sciences University, students can be exempted from the courses with the approval of the relevant faculty/institute after the content of the course is evaluated.

PROGRAM INFORMATION
